Rules and Regulations **Bowling**

1. LAW OF THE GAME

The normal rules of bowling will apply.

2. REPRESENTATION

- a) Each team must comprise 4 per bowlers with at least 1 lady and up to 2 reserves. A member of the team shall be designated as the Captains.
- b) No repetition or switching of bowlers is allowed.

3. FORMAT

- a) Each bowler will be playing 3 games. Therefore, there will be a total of 12 games (3 x 4 bowlers) per team.
- b) The winner will be decided by the highest pinfalls for the team.

4. SCORE

The winner shall be decided by the highest pinfalls for the total 12 games bowled. Should a tie occur during the tournament, the team with the highest game will win.

5. BOWLER'S ATTIRE

Bowlers are to be appropriately dressed for bowling. If in the opinion of the convener or his appointed officials on duty a bowler is not appropriately dressed, he may not be permitted to bowl.

6. VERIFICATION OF SCORES

It is responsibility of the Captain of each team to verify the correctness of each game bowled by signing the official score sheet which will be used as the official score recorded.

Once signed, the scores shall stand, unless otherwise decided by the convener.

In the event that the official score sheet is not signed for any reason, the convener reserves the right to refuse acceptance of the score sheet.

7. COMPUTER SCOREBOARD MALFUNCTION

In the event that a mechanical malfunction occurs and changes have to be made to the computer scoreboard, the convener or his appointed officials must be present before any changes can be made.

The officials will indicate the fact in the score sheet before the end of the game. If an official is not present to witness the amendment, the score for the bowler in that game will not be taken into account in the total score.

8. LANE ALLOCATION

Lanes will be allocated based on the number picked by ISCA.

9. BOWLING ON WRONG LANE

If a bowler bowls on the wrong lane(s) and the error is discovered before another bowler has bowled, a dead ball shall be declared and the bowler(s) will be required to re-bowl on the correct lane(s).

If the error is not discovered until the next bowler has bowled, the scores shall count and the bowlers shall be required to bowl his subsequent frames on the wrong lane.

10. PROTESTS

- a) Errors in scoring or errors in calculation will be corrected by the convener or his appointed officials upon discovery of such errors. Protest involving errors in scoring will be only be entertained if such protest is brought to the attention of the convener or his appointed officials on duty on the spot.
- b) Protests involving fouls must be brought to the attention of the convener or his appointed officials before the delivery of the next ball. No protest will be entertained after the bowler has made his second delivery of the frame.

11. BLIND SCORE

In the absence of a bowler, a blind score shall be given.

In the event of injury, a flat score of 70 and 100 would be given to the ladies and men respectively.

12. HANDICAP PINS

No handicap pins shall be given to lady bowlers.

13. REFRESHMENT

All teams are to provide their own refreshments.
