Rules and Regulations **Volleyball**

1. LAW OF THE GAME

The normal rules of volleyball shall apply.

2. FORMAT

- a) Each team will field enough players to play 6 a-sides, with minimum of 3 ladies inside the court at all times. Each team can field up to 12 players.
- b) For firms fielding multiple teams, exchanges of players will not be allowed. Each player can only play for one team.
- c) Standard FIVB rules apply (refer to latest edition)
- d) All games will be played on a best-of-three-sets format (win 2 sets to win the match). Each set will be 25 points. Deuces apply (i.e. 2 points lead to win a set)

3. GENERAL RULES / SCORE

- i) **Use of libero** – is allowed, but following same rules as in previous years, male libero's can substitute male players only, while female liberos can substitute female players only. While we allow 2 liberos in the team, only 1 libero is allowed to be inside the court at any given point in time.
- ii) **Height of net** – we will be using 2.38 meters and 2.43 meters (OCBC Arena).
- iii) **Protests for official's calls** – There will be no protests that will be entertained post-match, any protest for calls made during the match can be raised by the captain and the resulting referee's decision will be final.
- iv) **Official balls** – KPMG will provide 1 official ball for every match. To improve efficiency, I am requesting each team to provide 1 ball each during your actual match as substitute balls, which means we have 3 working balls for each match (1 from KPMG, 1 from each team in the match)
- v) **Ball retrievers** – each team will provide 1 person (either from the line up or a volunteer) as ball retriever. If you have exactly 6 persons only who is coming, please inform me in advance so I can help out in getting volunteers.
- vi) **Linesmen** – As in previous years, there will be no linesmen, referee's decision will follow.
- vii) **Warm up** – Please arrive 1 hour before your scheduled games to warm up. However, do note that players will not be allowed to play on the sidelines when a match is ongoing to avoid disturbance and accidents.
- viii) **Antennae** will be provided.
- ix) **Scoreboards** - We are looking for scoreboards if any of the teams have, else we will use iPads with a scoring application.

- x) **Jersey numbers** – There is no restriction on jersey numbers (apart to limiting it to 2 digits max).

4. REFRESHMENT

All teams are to provide their own refreshments.
